I, unfortunately, was not able to take advantage of my pool goddess weekends because of COVID this summer and with Labor Day here, fall and cooler days are on the way so I found something to keep you warm. We published this recipe in our newsletter a couple of years ago and got some rave reviews. It's a little upsetting that summer is just about over but the circle of life goes on; thank you Elton John!

## GOUDA TO THE LAST DROP - Dutch Cheese Soup Recipe

INGREDIENTS: 1 onion, 2 carrots, 2 celery stalks, 3 cloves garlic, 6 cups cauliflower florets, 3 tablespoons extra-

virgin olive oil, divided, salt and ground white pepper to taste, 1 bay leaf, 6 cups chicken broth, 2 cups grated gouda, 1 teaspoon mustard (Dijon-style or English) ¼ cup half-and-half, 1 tablespoon butter, 1 sprig fresh rosemary, chopped coarsely and 2 to 3 thin slices of prosciutto, julienned

PREPARATION: Roughly chop the onion, carrots, celery and garlic and combine with the cauliflower, 1 tablespoon of the olive oil and salt and pepper in a large soup pot. Cook over medium heat until vegetables soften, and onions become translucent, about 20-25 minutes.

Add the bay leaf and chicken broth and bring to a simmer. Cover and cook for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove the bay leaf and purée soup until smooth.

Just prior to serving the soup, stir in the gouda, mustard, half-and-half and butter. Taste and season with salt and pepper if needed. Continue cooking until cheese has melted and soup is smooth, 1 to 2 minutes.



In a small pan, heat remaining tablespoon of olive oil over medium-high heat and quickly fry the rosemary and prosciutto until crispy and aromatic.

Divide soup into bowls and garnish with the rosemary and prosciutto.

Makes 8-10 servings.

We will also be discussing Oberammergau 2022.



## What medical records should a traveler carry when traveling abroad?

- Physician name, phone # and fax #
- Name and phone # of home hospital
- Insurance ID cards or a copy with the ID# and Customer Service Phone number
- List of know medical problems (such as high blood pressure, diabetes, heart problems)
- List of hospitalizations and past surgeries, including dates, diagnosis and type of procedures
- ID cards for any surgical implants (i.e. joint surgery for hip or knee, pacemaker, cardiac stents)
- List of current medications with dosage and times of day taken. The complete list should also include prescriptions and over the counter medications, vitamins and herbal supplements.
- Allergies to medications and foods
- Blood type
- List of vaccinations and when received
- ICE Contact In Case of Emergency List name(s) of person to notify back home, include relationship and phone numbers. Leave a copy of all this information with that ICE contact, including copies of insurance ID cards (front and back), copy of passport, travel insurance policy information, and travel itinerary.
