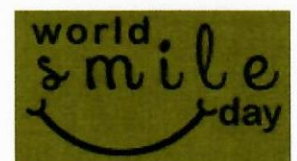

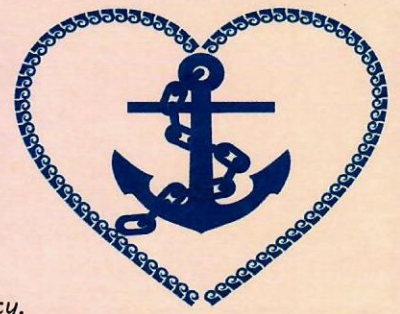
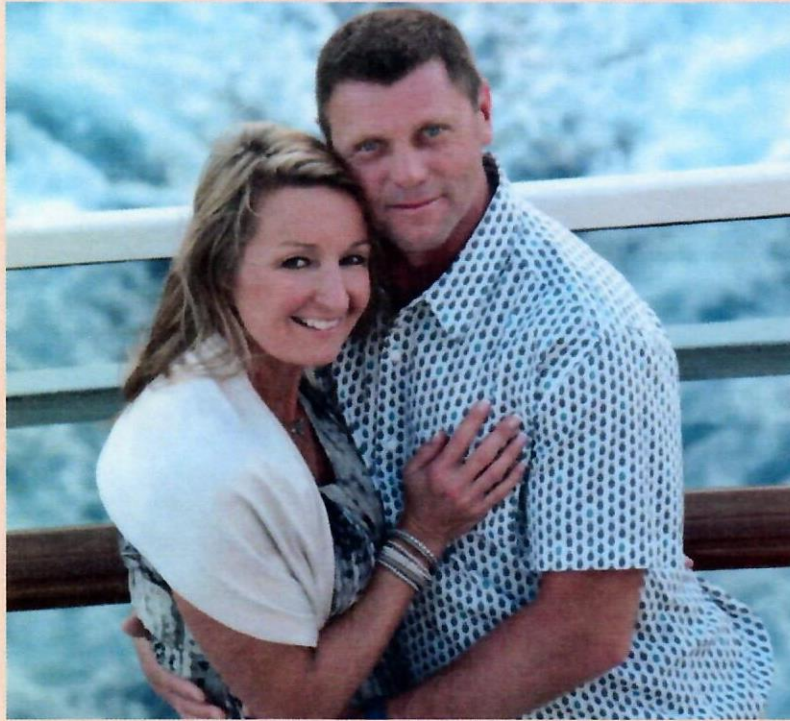

To avoid rampant land speculation, he purchased land under dummy corporations for years. His first choice near Sanford, Florida rejected his early overtures. Disney died in 1966 and did not see the completion of his visionary...



TSA PreClearance Will Be Expanded to Foreign Airports

Those enrolled in the Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) PreClearance program will soon be able to use it at foreign airports, according to a joint announcement this week from the TSA and the Customs and Border Protection (CBP) agencies.

"U.S. Customs and Border Protection announced today that it will invite new airports to participate in the PreClearance program for the first time since 2016," CBP said on Wednesday.

CBP has begun allowing foreign airports to apply for the program this week and TSA Administrator David P. Pekoske confirmed the news, writing that the TSA joins CBP "in announcing new foreign airports may now apply to join PreClearance so they can offer secure and seamless travel to their travelers heading to the United States from international destinations."

To be allowed in the program, foreign airports must meet a number of requirements—they must first host a U.S. air carrier operation, then have a suitable facility for the PreClearance processing, and be open to sharing the costs of the program with the U.S. government.

The airports must also have the same security standards and protocols that the U.S. government requires from its own airports, including new COVID-19 standards that the CBP and the TSA have put in place.

"PreClearance requires bilateral agreements between the United States and the host country, so it is essential for interested airports to coordinate closely with their governments throughout the application processes," CBP said.

There are already 16 foreign airports spread across six countries that have the program.

How To Make the Best Macaroni and Cheese on the Stove



Instructions

1. **Cook the pasta.** Bring about 4 quarts of salted water to a boil over high heat in a large pot. Add the pasta and cook according to package directions until al dente, about 8 minutes. Drain and set aside.
2. **Warm the milk.** Place 1 cup of the milk in a medium saucepan over medium heat. Meanwhile, place the remaining 1/2 cup of milk and flour in a small bowl and whisk together until there are no lumps. When you just start to see wisps of steam rising from the warming milk, whisk in the milk-and-flour mixture. Continue whisking gently until the milk thickens slightly to the consistency of heavy cream, 2 to 4 minutes.
3. **Make the cheese sauce.** Turn the heat to low and begin mixing handfuls of cheese into the milk. Stir in the salt and mustard. Stir until all the cheese has melted and the sauce is creamy. Taste and adjust the seasonings as desired. Remove the sauce from the heat.
4. **Combine the pasta and cheese sauce.** Place the pasta and 1/2 of the cheese sauce in a large serving bowl. Stir to coat the pasta evenly. Add the remaining sauce and any extra add-ins and stir to combine. If you'd like a looser sauce, add up to another 1/4 cup milk if desired. Serve the mac and cheese immediately while still warm.

Ingredients

- 1 pound dried short pasta, such as macaroni
- 1 1/2 cups whole or 2% milk, divided
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 2 to 3 cups shredded cheese, such as cheddar, Monterey Jack, or Colby
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/4 teaspoon powdered mustard
- Optional extras (cook before adding): ham, cooked bacon, onions, peas, mushrooms, peppers, broccoli, cauliflower
