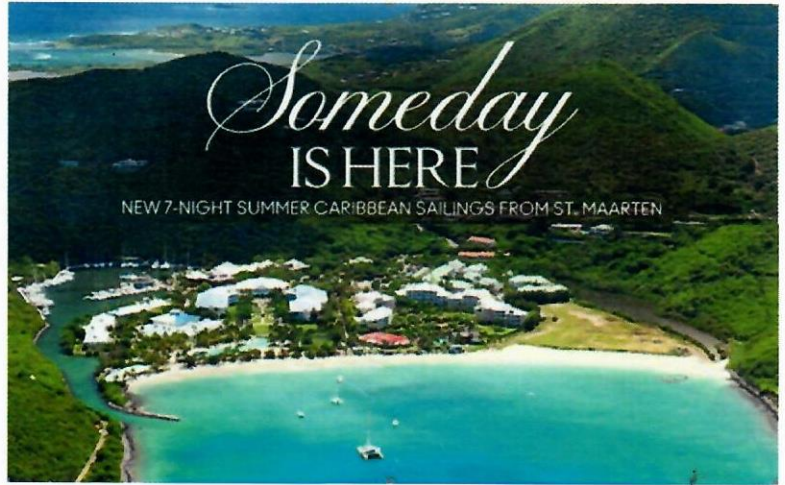

As announced by the Quintana Roo government on March 19, 2021, beginning April 1, all international visitors to the Mexican state of Quintana Roo, 15 years and older, will need to pay a Tourist Usage Fee of \$224 Mexican pesos (MXN), approximately \$10 USD depending on the exchange rate. Popular vacation destinations in the state include, but are not limited to Cancun, the Riviera Maya, Playa Del Carmen, Tulum, and Cozumel.

NEW TOURIST USAGE FEE FOR QUINTANA ROO, MEXICO



Payment must be made prior to the traveler's departure using an official payment platform which will be available in the upcoming days.

The following information will be required:

- Number of people traveling
- Name, age, and passport number - for each traveler
- Departure date
- Data to make the payment electronically

Families or groups can make one payment, as long as each individual is listed on the registration form. Individual payment receipts will be provided.

Confirmation of this payment must be shown during the departure security filter in order to continue to departure gates for departing flights.

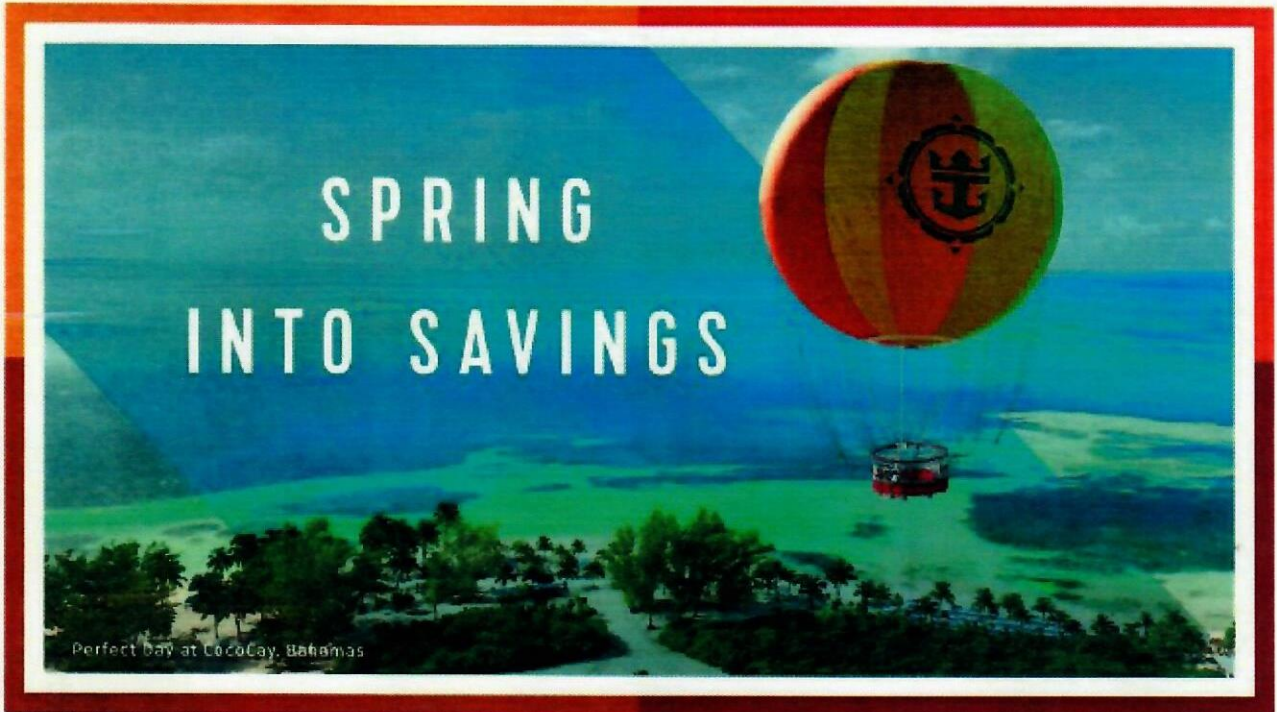
Iceland Getaway—The Land of Fire and Ice

Greece Will Welcome Travelers Again Starting on May 14



Greece is readying to again welcome international tourists starting on May 14.

Greece's Tourism Minister Harry Theocharis made the announcement this week.

All inbound travelers will need either to be vaccinated, have COVID-19 antibodies, or produce a negative test upon arrival. All will also be subject to random testing. Greece is ready to with a complete protocol for summer 2021.

Greece believes that the continued vaccine rollout (Greece is continuing to roll out the AstraZeneca vaccine to its residents despite other European countries pausing their own rollouts) will make it safe for inbound travelers starting in mid-May.

Israel Looks Ahead to Reopening for Tourism

Thanks to a robust vaccination program (one of the fastest in the world), the Israel Ministry of Tourism is hopeful that the country will be able to welcome back tourists from the U.S. and Canada soon.

Israel had already vaccinated some 80 percent of its adult population and was turning it into not only an attractive destination but a healthy destination. Tourism will start sooner than others will expect. Thailand and Greece have opened to tourism, and there are more and more vaccines being administered. It's a very positive sign

American Airlines has recently announced the launch of a direct daily flight from JFK to Tel Aviv starting May 6, 2021, as well as a nonstop flight from Miami to Tel Aviv, three times a week beginning in June. New Yorkers have other options as well with direct flights weekly on Delta, United Airlines and EL AL Airlines.

Israel will also welcome Royal Caribbean International's brand-new ship, Odyssey of the Seas, which will begin sailing from Israel for the first time in May (sailings are not available to US citizens).





Disneyland looks to reopen by late April after yearlong closure due to COVID-19 pandemic

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Disneyland is aiming to open by late April following a yearlong closure because of the COVID-19 pandemic. An exact date has not been pinpointed yet, but should be publicized in the coming weeks. Under the new plan, amusement parks will be eligible to open once more with capacity limits beginning April 1. That's provided the county they are located in meets the state's standards of its four-tier, color-coded system guiding sector reopening. [Theme parks can open](#) with 15% capacity when its county gets into the red tier, which is the second most-restrictive phase. In the orange tier, which is less-restrictive, maximum capacity jumps to 25%. In the least-restrictive yellow tier, capacity increases to 35%. The state is also encouraging the parks to limit attendance to California residents only. Orange County, home to Disneyland, Disney California Adventure and Knott's Berry, remains in the most-restrictive purple tier.

U.K. Update From VisitBritain

Earlier this month, VisitBritain held the ExploreGB conference virtually. In general, the outlook for summer and beyond is very optimistic: Suppliers are preparing and eagerly awaiting international tourists and are thrilled about all the interest in England from the hit Netflix series "Bridgerton."



The U.K. Government has recently published its 'roadmap' out of restrictions, setting out the timeframes and process for restarting tourism including international travel and for businesses in England to start planning towards reopening.



Spinach-Artichoke Dip

In Wonton Cups



Ingredients: 12 wonton wrappers, cooking spray, 1/2 of a 10 oz. package of frozen spinach (thawed and very well strained), 1 8oz. can of artichoke hearts (drained and finely chopped), 1/3 cup of mayonnaise, 1/4 cup sour cream. 2 oz. cream cheese (at room temperature), 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese, 2 cloves garlic (finely minced).

Directions: Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Arrange wonton wrappers in a standard 12-cup muffin pan then spray them lightly with cooking spray. Bake the wonton cups for five minutes then remove them from the oven and set them aside. In a medium bowl, stir together all the ingredients. Divide the spinach mixture evenly among the wonton cups then return them to the oven for 10-12 minutes until the spinach mixture is warm and the wonton cups are golden brown.
