



What's New in San Diego

The new Sanford Children's Zoo at the world-famous [San Diego Zoo](#) is slated to open in late 2021. Families will be able to venture through four ecosystems - Desert Dunes, Wild Woods, Marsh Meadows and Rainforest- and explore communities of wildlife that have unique adaptations for their environment. The remodeled exhibit will provide kids greater opportunities to discover the natural world through play.

On the hair-raising ride, guests dangle and drop more than 150 feet before plunging 90 degrees into exhilarating loops, a tribute to the Emperor penguins' journey from chilly, frosted cliffs to their deep dive into the depths of the ocean.

MEET YOUR NEW ID. THE ONE THAT'S READY TO FLY.

Be your REAL ID self by **October 1, 2021**

Starting October 1, 2021, you must have a **REAL ID** compliant driver license/ID to fly within the U.S., unless you use a U.S. passport or another federally approved form of identification.

UNTIL THAT DATE, a Standard New Jersey driver license is valid for air travel within the U.S.

WHAT TO BRING

2+1+6=REAL ID

- 2 proofs of residential address
- 1 proof of Social Security Number
- 6 points of ID



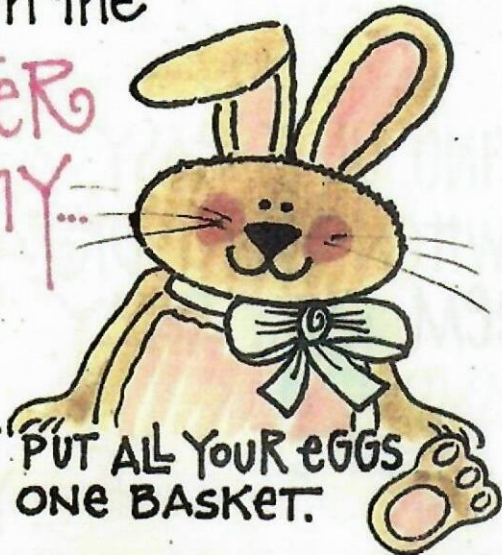
You are not required to get a **REAL ID**, however, starting October 1, 2021, if you typically use your driver license or non-driver ID (instead of a passport or other form of ID) to fly within the U.S. you probably want a **REAL ID**. Otherwise you will need to use a valid U.S. passport or another **federally approved** form of identification. The Standard New Jersey driver license can still be used for driving.

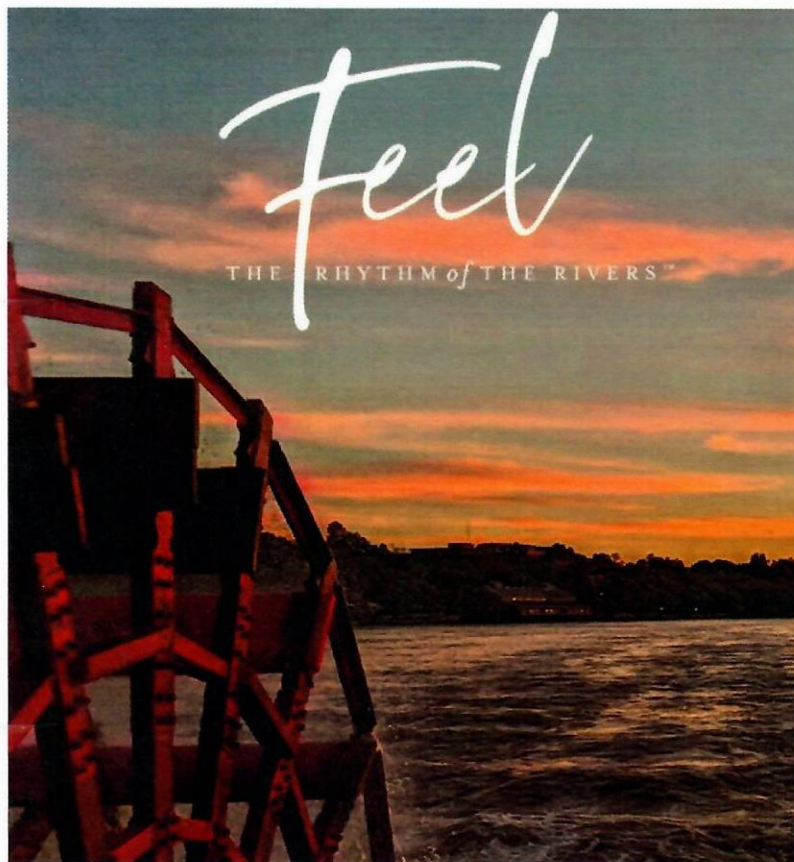
Iceland Getaway—The Land of Fire and Ice

Cover yourself with the healing mud and leave looking years younger. Not to be missed is a full day Golden Circle tour where you will visit magnificent waterfalls and geysers along with a stop at Thingvillar National Park; Iceland's Grand Canyon and the home to the oldest parliament in Europe. We will also attempt to see the Northern Lights (never guaranteed) and if nothing is spotted one night, we will try again the next night. There is a free day for your own experiences and sightseeing. Tour the inside of a glacier or the black sand beaches of the south coast. 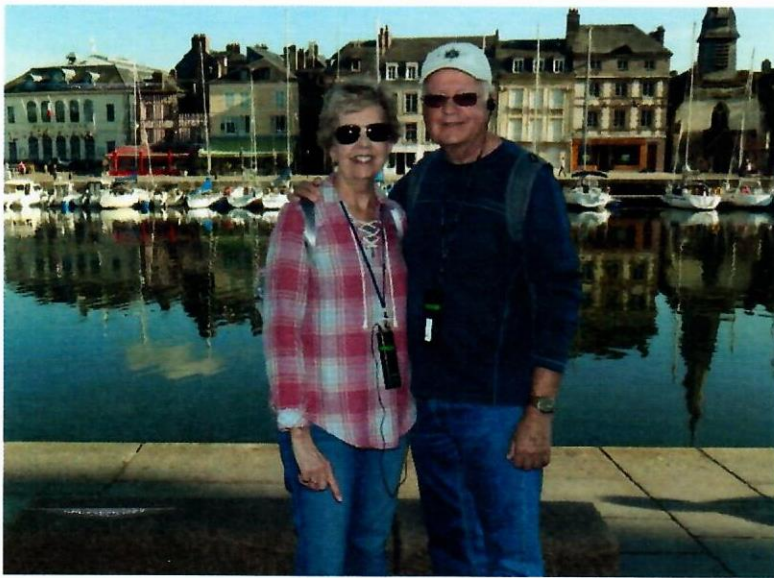

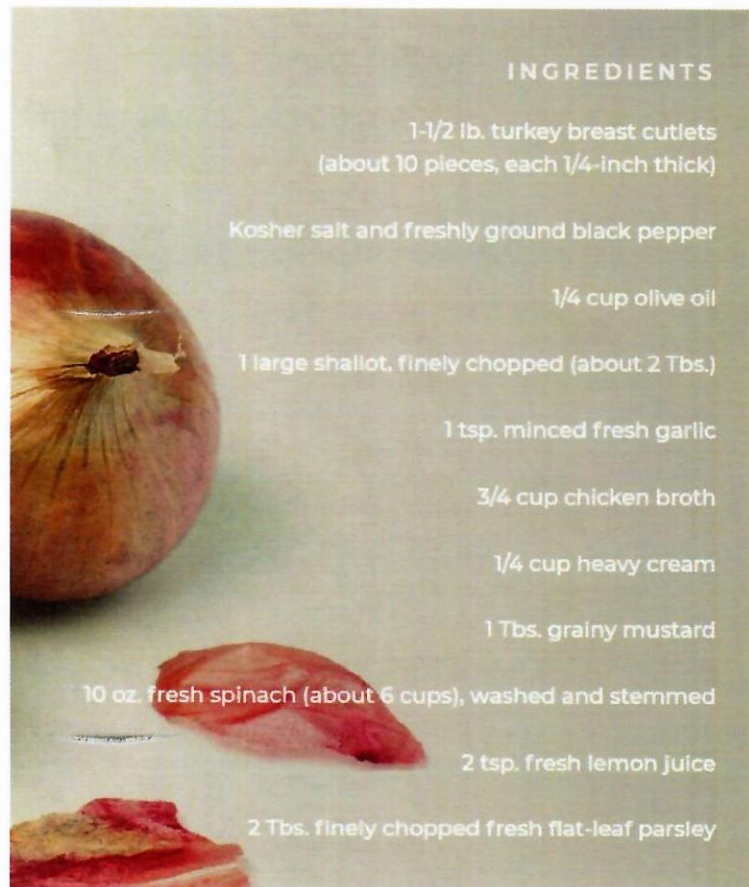
Turkey Cutlets

AND MUSTARD
CREAM SAUCE

~ FROM STAR CLIPPERS' GALLEY ~

DIRECTIONS

Season turkey with salt and pepper. Heat 2 Tbs. of the oil in a large skillet over medium high heat. Brown the turkey until cooked through, 1 to 2 minutes per side. Transfer to a plate and cover with foil. Reduce heat to low and add 1 tbs olive oil and the shallots and sauté, stirring frequently, until it softens slightly (about 3 minutes). Add 1/2 tsp. of garlic and sauté for another 30 seconds



Increase heat to high, add broth and cook until it reduces by half (about 5 minutes). Add cream and mustard and cook 1-2 minutes, whisking until thickened. Season with salt and pepper and set aside. Heat remaining 1 tbs oil in another large skillet over medium heat; add remaining 1/2 tsp garlic. Sauté for 15 seconds (do not burn garlic). Add spinach and cover pan; cook, stirring occasionally, until spinach wilts completely (about 2 minutes). Toss with lemon juice; remove from heat.

Serve immediately by adding spinach in the middle of each plate, top with the turkey and the sauce; add a sprinkling of parsley if desired.
