# Alitalia Is Ceasing Operations October 14



Alitalia is stopping ticket sales and, as a consequence, interrupting flight activities starting from October 15, 2021. The announcement follows the sale of the Aviation branch of 'Alitalia - Società Aerea Italiana Spa' to the fully public owned company Italia Trasporto Aereo S.p.A.

As a result, Alitalia is offering passengers holding a ticket for flights purchased by and not after August 24, 2021, with a travel date from October 15, 2021, to/from any destination/origin worldwide, that have been canceled, the forms of assistance and reimbursement below, of their choice:

- Change of booking (rebooking or rerouting, or modification of the itinerary to reach the original destination or return to the point of origin of the trip), without fare integration, on a flight that can be used by the passenger, by October 14, 2021 (final date of return);
- Change of destination with possible fare integration, to travel by October 14, 2021 (final date of return). There is no refund for differences in the fare.

Passengers can also request the full refund, without penalty, of the price at which the ticket was purchased or the residual value of the ticket for the journey not yet made.

### U.S. Will Require Face Masks Planes into 2022

On Tuesday, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) confirmed reports that the federal transportation face mask mandate would be extended into January 2022 because of ongoing COVID-19 concerns.

The news, <u>first reported by Reuters</u>, means that passengers on planes, trains, buses, and at airports and train stations, will be required to wear face coverings at all times. The original order, which has been in place since January, was set to expire next month.

"The universal wearing of masks in airports and on airplanes, trains and other forms of public transportation is both an effective safeguard against spreading the virus and boosts public confidence in traveling—both of which are paramount for a sustained economic recovery."

The mandate has had industry support but has caused problems for flight attendants, who have been tasked with enforcing the rule onboard.

According to data from the Federal Aviation Authority (FAA), more than 3,100 reports of passenger behavior have been reported just since January 1, with many of those complaints highlighting verbal abuse lobbed at flight attendants trying to enforce mask mandates onboard.

The problem has become bad enough for the Association of Professional Flight Attendants to call it "out of control" and "coming to the point where we have to defend ourselves" earlier this year. And for Airlines for America (A4A), the industry trade group for U.S. airlines, to write Attorney General Merrick Garland this week to urge "swift prosecution for cases of unruly passenger behavior."

The FAA, for its part, has upped enforcement and punishment for the behavior

#### Third Vaccine Dose Recommended for Immunocompromised Individuals


People with moderately to severely compromised immune systems who have received two doses of the Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccines should receive a third dose after the initial vaccine series. This additional dose is intended to make sure that immunocompromised individuals have enough protection against COVID-19 as they may not build the same level of immunity from the two-





dose vaccine series as people who are not immunocompromised. Any eligible person can get a third dose at any existing vaccination location – they should bring documentation of the vaccine doses they have received.

Separately, New Jersey is preparing for booster doses of the COVID-19 vaccine for the general public, pending federal approval and recommendation. A booster dose is a supplemental dose of vaccine given to people when the immune response weakens over time.

# Instant Pot Frozen Chicken Teriyaki with Rice and Broccoli



1 cup long-grain white rice, rinsed and drained, 4 cups broccoli florets (about 12 ounces), 2 tablespoons canola oil, 2 cloves garlic, finely chopped (about 2 tablespoons), 2 scallions, greens and whites separated, finely chopped, 1 teaspoon finely grated peeled fresh ginger, 1/3 cup low-sodium chicken broth, 3 tablespoons soy sauce, 2 tablespoons packed brown sugar, 2 tablespoons honey, 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt, 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper, 2 frozen chicken breasts (6 to 8 ounces each) and 2 teaspoons cornstarch.

Add 1 1/4 cups water and the rice to a 6- or 8-quart Instant Pot\*. Place the broccoli on top of the rice. Follow the manufacturer's guide for locking the lid and preparing to cook. Set to pressure cook on high for 5 minutes (see Cook's Note). After the pressure-cook cycle is complete, follow the manufacturer's guide for natural release. After 10 minutes, being careful of any remaining steam, unlock and remove the lid. Gently scoop out the broccoli and rice into a medium bowl, cover with plastic wrap and set aside until ready to serve. Add the oil, garlic, scallion whites and ginger to the same pot (there is no need to rinse the pot out). Set to high saute for 4 minutes and cook until softened, stirring frequently with a wooden spoon. Add the broth, soy sauce, brown sugar, honey, salt and black pepper, scraping the browned bits from the bottom of the pot with a wooden spoon.

Add the chicken breasts. Follow the manufacturer's guide for locking the lid and preparing to cook. Set to pressure cook on high for 6 minutes; (for a 6-ounce chicken breast) to 8 minutes (for an 8-ounce breast). After the pressure-cook cycle is complete, follow the manufacturer's guide for natural release.

After 10 minutes, being careful of any remaining steam, unlock and remove the lid. Transfer the chicken to a cutting board using tongs and slice crosswise.

In a small bowl, combine the cornstarch with 2 teaspoons cold water and add to the sauce in the pot. Set to high saute for 4 minutes.

Continuously whisk until the teriyaki sauce is thickened.

Drizzle the sauce over the sliced chicken

and serve with the cooked rice and broccoli.
