

Adventures by Disney is Heading to the Arctic in 2023



Ten months after announcing its plans to take guests to Antarctica, Adventures by Disney is adding the world's other polar region to its offerings.

On Wednesday, Adventures by Disney announced a new Arctic expedition cruise for 2023, a 10-day itinerary that will sail twice in 2023, once in June and once in July. The sailings will both take place on a chartered Ponant ship, Le Boreal.

The July sailing will include access to Joe Rohde, a former Walt Disney Imagineer who was the lead designer of Disney's Animal Kingdom and one of the lead designers behind Disney's Aulani property in Hawaii. Rohde retired from Walt Disney Imagineering in January and currently serves as the experience architect at Virgin Galactic.

Guests on the itineraries will start in Oslo with an overnight stay at the Grand Hotel Oslo and a welcome dinner. They will then fly to Svalbard to board Ponant's Le Boreal, a 264 capacity ship specifically designed to sail the arctic regions.

From there, guests will get to explore locations around Svalbard, starting in Longyearbyen, the world's northernmost settlement in the archipelago. Each day, guests will get to join daily zodiac excursions and landings and take part in wildlife sightings of polar bears, reindeer, arctic foxes, puffins, and more. Reservations will be available today, November 12th.

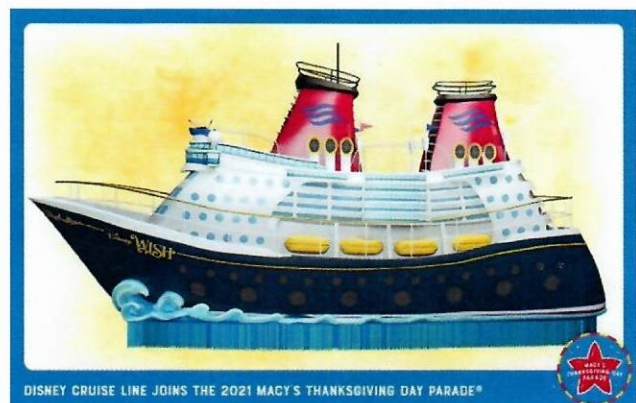
At the same time, Disney announced three new departures for those previous Antarctica itineraries that were announced in January. The new additions start in December 2022 and run through early 2023. Disney is also now offering a four-day pre-cruise excursion in Buenos Aires.

Disney Wish Float to Sail During Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade

The maiden voyage for Disney Cruise Line's newest ship will actually take place months earlier, and about 1,000 miles north, of its scheduled summer 2022 debut.

Disney on Thursday revealed that a brand-new cruise ship float of Disney Wish will take part in the 95th Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade this November. The float, which Disney is calling "Magic Meets the Sea," will join the festivities in New York City on Thursday, Nov. 25 starting at 9 a.m. EST.

The float is inspired by Disney Wish, with the same design elements adorning the float's exterior, including the Mickey Mouse-inspired color palette, red funnels, and filigree motif along the hull. The celebration will also feature 15 of Disney's most beloved characters, including Captain Minnie Mouse, Princess Tiana, Aladdin and Jasmine, Cinderella, and more.

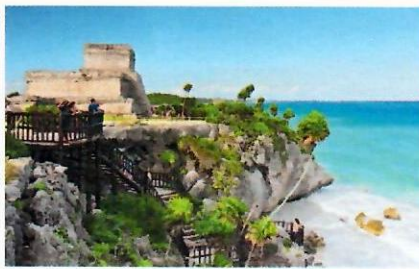

Celebrity Cruises is returning to Egypt after a 10-year hiatus



[Celebrity Cruises](#) will make its first call in Egypt in more than 10 years, when the [Celebrity Apex](#) visits Alexandria in 2023.

The Apex and its two Edge-class sisters will all be based in Europe in summer 2023, as they will be in summer 2022, along with four other Celebrity ships, continuing the line's focus on Europe in its upcoming summer deployments.

The [Celebrity Beyond](#), debuting in spring 2022, the [Celebrity Edge](#) and the Apex will join the [Celebrity Silhouette](#), the [Celebrity Constellation](#), the [Celebrity Infinity](#) and the [Celebrity Reflection](#), to offer more than 45 overnight stays in 11 different cities on itineraries ranging in length from four to 13 days.

The Apex will make the call in Egypt, the line's first since 2012, on a 10-day sailing to Israel, Egypt and the Mediterranean featuring an overnight in Alexandria, where guests will be able to visit the Pyramids and the Sphinx.

The Beyond will sail the Eastern Mediterranean from Rome; the Infinity will homeport in Lisbon, offering nine-day Spain and Portugal, and in Athens, where along with the Constellation, it will offer a variety of sailings through Greece and the Eastern Mediterranean. The Reflection will also sail the Greek islands, offering late-night stays in places such as Mykonos, Santorini and Rhodes.
