All Celebrity Cruises' Edge-Class Ships Will Sail in Europe in 2023

Celebrity Cruises on Tuesday revealed its 2023 European cruising schedule, one that includes all three of Celebrity's newest Edge-class cruise ships.

Celebrity Beyond (debuting in 2022), Celebrity Apex, and Celebrity Edge, along with four other Celebrity ships, will all sail out of Europe in 2023, making the year-after-next a big European year for the cruise line. The sailings will range from 4- to 13-nights with more 7-night sailings in Europe than ever before for Celebrity.

The schedule includes ports such as Flam in Norway, Lisbon in Portugal, Kotka in Finland, and Jerusalem in Israel. It also includes the first Celebrity ship to visit Egypt since 2012—Celebrity Apex, on a new 10-night sailing around Israel, Egypt, and the Mediterranean—and a first-of-its-kind sailing from Amsterdam to Norwegian Fjords, also on Apex.

All of the itineraries include Celebrity's new all-inclusive fare called "Always Included," which was revealed during 2020. That fare includes WiFi, drinks, and service charges and is part of what Celebrity believes to be the new standard for luxury cruise passengers going forward.

Royal Caribbean Announces First-Ever World Cruise

Royal Caribbean is going big with its first-ever World Cruise. The 274-night Ultimate World Cruise will be the longest world cruise ever, visiting all seven continents and more than 150 destinations in 65 countries.

Serenade of the Seas will depart from Miami on December 10, 2023, and return to the same port on September 10, 2024. The itinerary will include 57 destinations new to the cruise line.

Guests will be able to visit some of the world's most spectacular landmarks including Peru's Machu Picchu, Japan's Mount Fuji, and India's Taj Mahal.

Cruisers can book the entire Ultimate World Cruise or one of four segments:

Round the Horn: Americas and Antarctica Expedition (Miami to L.A., Dec. 10, 2023 – Feb. 11, 2024)

This nearly two-month-long cruise segment begins in Miami and visits three continents and 36 destinations, including several Caribbean islands, and cities in Mexico, Peru, Brazil, and Argentina. New Year's Eve will be spent in Rio de Janeiro and journey highlights will include glacier-studded Antarctica, Iguazu Falls in Argentina, and Cape Horn.

Wonders of Asia and the Pacific Expedition (L.A. to Dubai, Feb. 11 – May 9, 2024)

Cruisers will journey around Asia and Oceania on this nearly three-month-long segment that visits 40 destinations across three continents. Highlights include the Hawaiian Islands and Tahiti, New Zealand and Australia, and several stops in Asia including China, India, Japan, Vietnam, and Malaysia.

Middle East Treasures and Marvels of the Med Expedition (Dubai to Barcelona, May 9 – July 10, 2024)

The third segment of Royal Caribbean's Ultimate World Cruise begins in Dubai and visits several world wonders including Jordan's lost city of Petra, the Pyramids of Giza in Egypt, the Temple of Artemis in Turkey, and the Colosseum in Rome. Other highlights include Olympia, Greece; Split, Croatia; and Provence, France. All in all, this nearly three-month-long cruise visits 44 destinations across three continents.

Capitals of Culture (Barcelona to Miami, July 10 – Sept. 10, 2024)

The final leg of the Ultimate World Cruise begins in the Mediterranean, before heading north and then south back to Miami. Highlights of this 40-destination itinerary range from Barcelona to St. Petersburg, and the Norwegian Fjords and Iceland's Blue Lagoon to New York City.

Fares for the full Ultimate World Cruise, which range from \$60,000 to \$112,000 per person, include business class airfare, as well as an evening of festivities and accommodations at a five-star hotel before setting sail.

Crown & Anchor Society Platinum-status members and above will receive a bonus Seven New World Wonders shore excursion package, in addition to other perks including a Deluxe Beverage package, VOOM Wi-Fi, laundry service, and more.

U.S. will reopen Canada and Mexico land borders in November

The U.S. will reopen its land borders to nonessential travel next month, ending a 19-month freeze due to the COVID-19 pandemic as the country moves to require all international visitors to be vaccinated against the coronavirus.

Travelers entering the U.S. by vehicle, rail and ferry will be asked about their vaccination status as part of the standard U.S. Customs and Border Protection admissions process. At officers' discretion, travelers will have their proof of vaccination verified in a secondary screening process.

Unlike air travel, for which proof of a negative Covid-19 test is required before boarding a flight to enter the U.S., no testing will be required to enter the U.S. by land or sea, provided the travelers meet the vaccination requirement.

According to the CDC, the U.S. will accept travelers who have been fully vaccinated with any of the vaccines approved for emergency use by the World Health Organization, not just those in use in the U.S.

WORLD'S LARGEST PIPE ORGAN

Built between 1929 and 1932 by the Midmer-Losh Organ Company of Merrick, Long Island, NY, the Boardwalk Hall pipe organ has 33,112 pipes and is the world's largest pipe organ. The 449 voices of the organ are controlled from a seven-keyboard console on the main stage of the arena. Although not fully functional for many decades, it is now being restored to its original grandeur.

The Adrian Phillips Theater is equipped with a magnificent Kimball pipe organ. Originally designed to provide the soundtrack for silent movies, the instrument can provide a wide variety of musical styles and genres and can give the effect of an entire symphony orchestra. There are 55 ranks of pipes in this instrument controlled from a four-manual console.

Best Things to Eat and Drink in Portugal

How to make a Portuguese Egg Custard



Read here our Authentic Leite Creme Recipe.

INGREDIENT (for eight people)

- 1 litter of milk
- 7 egg yolks
- 150g of sugar
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch flour
- 2 lemon peels
- 1 cinnamon stick
- Sugar q. s.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. In a bowl, combine the milk (set aside a little to mix the corn-starch) with the lemon peel and the cinnamon stick and boil and turn off.
2. Mix the egg yolks well with the corn starch and the flour with the little milk reserved.
3. Mix everything up.
4. Bring to the boil, constantly stirring until bubbling begins.
5. As soon as it begins to bubble, turn off the heat and remove the lemon peel.
6. Place the cream milk on a platter or tights.
7. After being cold and serving time, sprinkle with sugar and burn it with an iron suitable for the purpose.

Portuguese Egg Custard is not made using a bain-marie (a water bath or *banho Maria* in Portuguese).

My last suggestion: If you don't like the sugar on top, you can replace it with powder cinnamon.

Portuguese White Sangria

Makes a pitcher of Sangria.

- ✓ 500 ml bottle of Portuguese White Wine (dry wine)
- 150 ml soda or sparkling water
- 2 glasses of white Port wine (shot glass – or another wine brandy)
- 2 glasses of any whisky (shot glass)
- 2 oranges (sliced)
- 1 lemon (sliced)
- 1 apple (sliced)
- 2 cups of ice cubes
- 1 orange chopped (fresh fruit)
- ✓ 1 bunch white grapes, cut in half without the pits
- 1 apple chopped
- 1 or 2 cinnamon stick
- Some sugar, to taste
- Mint leaves



Add the ice, fruits, and sugar to the pitcher.
Add the liquids to the pitcher.
Mix it well with a spoon.
Let it sit for at least 10 to 15 minutes to chill.
Serve very cold!
