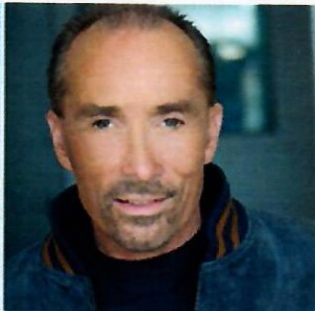
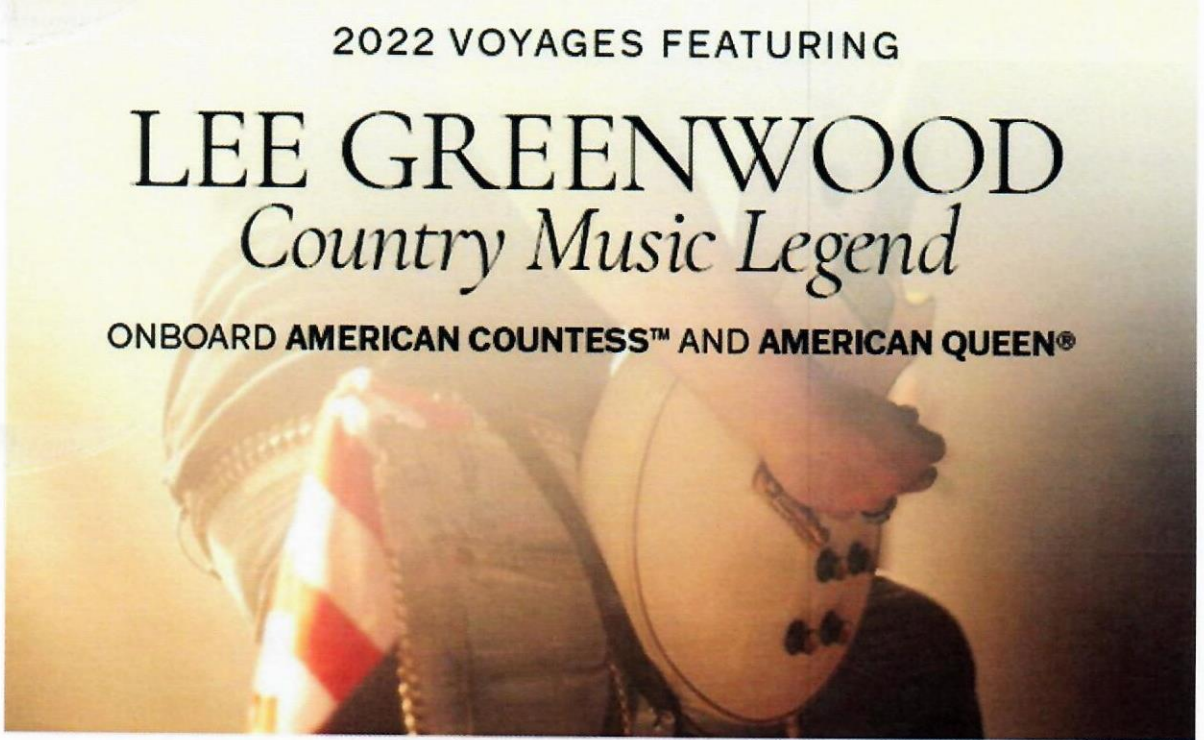

Denmark requires unvaccinated U.S. travelers to quarantine

In [Denmark](#), the rules have also changed. Vaccinated U.S. travelers are still welcome to enter Denmark, but those who have recovered from COVID-19 now need a “worthy purpose” to enter—such as for work, studies, family, legal, or real estate matters—and unvaccinated U.S. travelers must now quarantine after arrival in addition to providing a negative COVID-19 PCR test from within 72 hours of boarding and then getting tested again upon arrival (they didn’t have to quarantine before).

France, Greece, Austria, and other European countries have not yet announced changes

Neither France, Greece, nor Austria has updated its entry requirements yet, and it is unclear when or whether they will do so. The same is true for several additional countries in Europe.

The European Council recommends that only vaccinated travelers, those traveling for essential reasons, and those traveling for nonessential reasons from the list of approved countries should be allowed to enter the European Union. So, it is likely that as new conditions continue to be implemented, they will be most significant for unvaccinated travelers.

But as we’ve seen above in instances such as Sweden, Bulgaria, and the Netherlands, vaccinated U.S. travelers are not being totally spared prohibitive entry restrictions. Thus, travelers with forthcoming plans to travel to Europe, regardless of vaccination status, should keep a very close watch as updates continue throughout Europe.

Royal Caribbean Unveils Details on its New Ship, the World’s Largest



Royal Caribbean International has shared additional details on its new ship, *Wonder of the Seas*, which will be the world’s largest cruise ship when it launches.

It will be nearly 1,200 feet long, 210 feet wide and almost 237,000 gross tons. That’s enough space for 18 decks and 2,867 staterooms that accommodate up to 5,734 guests.

Guests can expect signature Oasis Class features, as well as a slew of new experiences. Some highlights, according to the video, are the **Solarium**, which is now fully enclosed to climatize the space; the **AquaTheater** entertainment venue at the rear of the ship, which will have a partial shelter for cooler temperatures; and the **Ultimate Abyss**, a three-story waterslide touted as the tallest at sea.

Inside, dining venues include **Giovanni’s Italian Kitchen & Wine Bar**, **Park Café** and the **Casino Royale**. An Oasis Class mainstay is the open-air **Central Park**, lined with upscale boutiques and restaurants, like **Chops Grille**. **The Boardwalk** (home to the AquaTheater) will also have a selection of casual eats, entertainment and “family fun,” including a carousel.

Good to know: *Wonder of the Seas* will be home to a new stateroom category, the **Suite Neighborhood**. This is located atop the ship and will offer guests exclusive experiences and amenities, such as dining at **Coastal Kitchen**.

CDC SELF TESTING GUIDE FOR RETURNING TO U.S.A.

Testing is critically important to help reduce the spread of COVID-19. If you have symptoms or have had a known exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, you should be tested regardless of your vaccination status. Quarantine if you have been in close contact (within 6 feet of someone for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period) with someone who has COVID-19, unless you have been fully vaccinated.

People who are fully vaccinated do NOT need to quarantine after contact with someone who had COVID-19 unless they have symptoms. Although the risk that fully vaccinated people could become infected with SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19 is low, any fully vaccinated person who experiences symptoms consistent with COVID-19 should isolate themselves from others, be clinically evaluated for COVID-19, and tested for SARS-CoV-2 if indicated. Get tested 3-5 days following a known exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 and wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days after exposure or until a negative test result.

Fully vaccinated individuals should follow [CDC's recommendations](#) for testing.

If you need to be tested for COVID-19 and can't get tested by a healthcare provider, you can consider using either a **self-collection kit** or a **self-test** that can be performed at home or anywhere else. Sometimes a self-test is also called a "home test" or an "at-home test." [FDAexternal icon](#) provides information on which self-tests are authorized for use.

These self-collection kits and tests are available either by prescription or over the counter, without a prescription, in a pharmacy or retail store. At present, self-collection kits and tests are used for the detection of [current infection](#).

Types of Specimens

Some tests require a **nasal specimen** that can be collected using an anterior nasal swab or a nasal mid-turbinate swab (see the [Print Resources](#) section below).

Other tests require a **saliva specimen**.

Prepare to Collect a Specimen

- Wash your hands with soap.
- Open the box and follow the manufacturer's instructions included with the specimen collection or test kit to collect your own nasal or saliva specimen. Once collected, send the specimen to a testing facility or use the specimen, as described in the manufacturer's instructions, to complete the self-test.
- If you don't collect the specimens as directed, your test results may be incorrect.

Performing the Test

Follow the manufacturer's instructions exactly and perform the steps in the order that they are listed. The manufacturer may also provide other resources, such as quick reference guides or instructional videos, to help you perform the test correctly.

Tips

- Store all test components according to the manufacturer's instructions until ready for use.
- Check the expiration date. Don't use expired tests or test components that are damaged or appear discolored based on the manufacturer's instructions.
- Clean the countertop, table, or other surfaces where you will do the test.
- Don't open test devices or other test components until you are ready to start the testing process.
- Read and record test results only within the amount of time specified in the manufacturer's instructions. A result read before or after the specified timeframe may be incorrect.
- Don't reuse test devices or other components.

After you have the results, discard the specimen collection swab and test kit in the trash, clean all surfaces that the specimen may have touched, and wash your hands.

Ingredients:

- 2 cups sifted all-purpose flour
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon ground allspice
- 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves
- 2/3 cup vegetable shortening
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 1/4 cup molasses
- 1 large egg, lightly beaten
- 1 teaspoon rum extract
- 2 tablespoons water
- 1 tablespoon apple cider vinegar
- 1 - 1/2 cups golden raisins
- 3/4 cup walnuts, chopped

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 375°F.

Prepare a 15x10x1 jelly roll pan by greasing bottom the bottom and sides.

Mix together flour, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, ginger, allspice, nutmeg, and cloves. Sift all ingredients together twice.

Cream together shortening and sugar.

Add molasses, egg, rum extract, water, and vinegar.

Pour batter into baking pan evenly.

Bake 17-20 minutes until bars turn light brown and a toothpick inserted in the middle comes out clean.

Let cool for 10 minutes.

Turn the pan onto a cooling rack to cool for an additional 10 minutes.

Place on a cutting board.

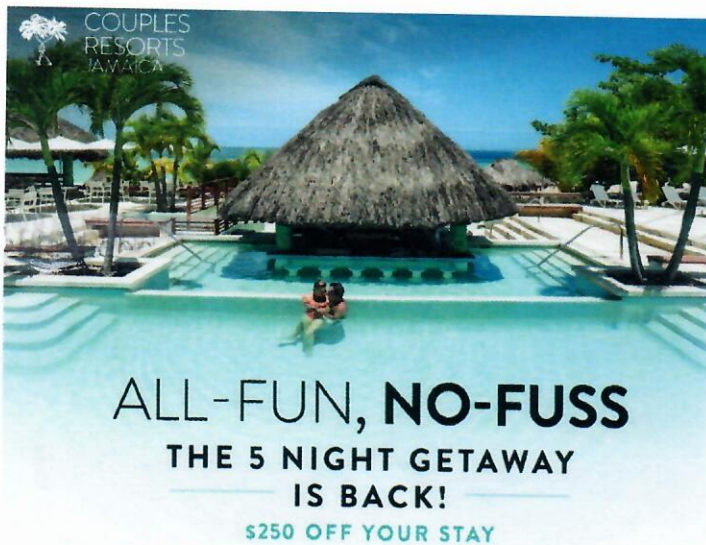
Glaze (optional):
