Deposits are non-refundable without insurance and final payment is due by November 4, 2022.

## No Knead Rosemary Bread

A basic, FOOLPROOF homemade bread recipe here! Anyone can make this! | PROMISE!!!! And the bread comes out just perfect!

Yield: 8 servings, prep time: 24 hours 15 minutes, cook time: 40 minutes.

Ingredients:

3 cups ail-purpose flour

3 large garlic cloves, minced

1 tablespoon finely chopped fresh rosemary, or more, to taste

1 1/4 teaspoons kosher salt

3/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

1/2 teaspoon instant yeast

1 1/2 cups water, at room temperature

2 tablespoons cornmeal



#### Directions:

In a large bowl, combine flour, garlic, rosemary, salt, pepper and yeast.

Using a wooden spoon or your hand, add water and mix until a wet, sticky dough forms, about 30 seconds.

Cover bowl tightly with plastic wrap and let stand at room temperature until surface is dotted with bubbles, about 18 to 24 hours.

Lightly oil a 10-inch cast iron skillet or coat with nonstick spray; sprinkle with cornmeal.

Working on a lightly floured surface, gently shape dough into a round.

Place dough into the prepared skillet. Cover with a clean dishtowel and let stand at room temperature until dough has doubled in size and does not readily spring back when poked with a finger, about 2 hours.

Preheat oven to 450 degrees F. Place into oven and bake until golden brown, about 30-40 minutes.

Serve warm.

# US lifts COVID-19 test requirement for international travel

The Biden administration is lifting its requirement that international air travelers to the U.S. take a COVID-19 test within a day before boarding their flights, easing one of the last remaining government mandates meant to contain the spread of the coronavirus.

A senior administration official said the mandate expires Sunday at 12:01 a.m. ET, saying the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has determined that it's no longer necessary. The official, speaking Friday on the condition of anonymity to preview the formal announcement, said that the agency would reevaluate the need for the testing requirement every 90 days and that it could be reinstated if a troubling new variant emerges









### Why a Busy Hurricane Season Won't Impact Travel This Summer

Seems like travel just can't catch a break. First it was the pandemic, then a war that has driven up prices and now the National Oceanic and Atmosphere Administration (NOAA) is predicting an above-average hurricane season this year. Indeed, NOAA just reported some of the earliest storms of the season.

This summer U.S. travelers are returning to Italy, the U.K., and France more than any other countries, replacing tropical getaways that remained open and popular throughout the pandemic, including Costa Rica, Turks & Caicos, and the British Virgin Islands and U.S. Virgin Islands.

COVID-19 still more concerning to travelers than hurricanes, with 88 percent of people interviewed indicated they weren't worried about a hurricane impacting their travels this summer. Of those travelers, almost 40 percent are planning to travel to Europe, compared to just 16 percent visiting the Caribbean.

In contrast, 40 percent of summer travelers have specifically sought out coverage for contracting COVID-19, including cancellation, medical and quarantine benefits. This is by far the biggest concern for travelers this summer.

Most travel insurance policies include coverage for contracting Covid-19, as well as hurricane and weather benefits at no additional cost.
