# CREAMY TORTELLINI WITH HAM AND PEAS

## **INGREDIENTS**

2 CUPS OF WATER, 2 CUPS CHICKEN STOCK, 12 OZ. TORTELLINI, 1 10 OZ. BAG FROZEN PEAS, 1/2 CUP DICED HAM, 1 TBL. OLIVE OIL, 2 CLOVES MINCED GARLIC, 1 TSP. ITALIAN SEASONING, 1 CUP MOZZARELLA CHEESE, 1/4 CUP GRATED PARMESAN CHEESE AND 1/4 CUP WHOLE MILK OR HEAVY CREAM.

## **DIRECTIONS**

IN THE INNER POT, COMBINE THE WATER, CHICKEN STOCK, TORTELLINI, PEAS, DICES HAM, OLIVE OIL, GARLIC AND ITALIAN SEASONING. STIR AND MAKE SURE THAT THE PASTA IS COMPLETELY SUBMERGED IN THE LIQUID. USE MORE WATER IF NEEDED TO HAVE THE PASTA COMPLETELY SUBMERGED. SECURE THE LID AND PRESSURE COOK ON HIGH FOR FIVE MINUTES, THEN QUICKLY RELEASE THE PRESSURE AND REMOVE THE LID. PRESS CANCEL TO STOP ADDITIONAL COOKING. STIR IN MOZZARELLA AND PARMESAN CHEESES WHILE PASTA IS STILL PIPING HOT. ADD MILK OR HEAVY CREAM AND STIR IN LAST. SERVE WHILE PASTA IS STILL HOT.

# Fast-growing MSC Cruises sails into the New York market, heats up competition



Get ready for a major new option when it comes to cruises from New York City.

On Tuesday, fast-growing MSC Cruises announced it would begin year-round sailings from the Big Apple in 2023 — a move that will put it head-to-head with Royal Caribbean and Norwegian Cruise Line in the market.

The world's third-largest cruise brand said it would move a single ship, the 4,500-passenger MSC Meraviglia, from Port Canaveral, Florida, to New York City in April 2023 to operate a range of six- to 11-night voyages to the <u>Caribbean</u>, Bermuda, New England and <u>Canada</u>.

The announcement marks a significant milestone for MSC Cruises, a Europe-based brand that, until now, has only offered sailings in North America out of Miami and Port Canaveral.

"New York City was the natural choice when we picked our next U.S. port because it's so accessible, whether the guest is coming from somewhere nearby or from around the world," MSC Cruises USA president Rubén Rodríguez said in a statement.

As part of its expansion, MSC Cruises has been rapidly building its footprint in North America in an effort to woo more Americans. In 2017, MSC Cruises only had a single vessel based in North America. It now has two vessels based in Miami and one more sailing out of Port Canaveral.

# CARIBBEAN COVID UPDATES

# ST. LUCIA



The Government of **Saint Lucia** has announced updates to its international arrival protocols. Beginning Saturday, March 5, 2022, fully vaccinated travelers and in-transit passengers aged five and over must have a negative rapid antigen test or a PCR test taken one day prior to entering Saint Lucia. Travelers may also provide a negative RT-PCR COVID-19 test taken up to five days prior to arrival.

All unvaccinated travelers must present a negative RT-PCR COVID-19 test, taken up to five days prior to entering Saint Lucia. All travelers must register their information and upload test results online prior to travel on <a href="https://www.stlucia.org/covid-19">www.stlucia.org/covid-19</a>. On completion, they will receive an automatic "ready to go" email. The previous two-step approval process is no longer required for boarding.

# **BARBADOS**



The **Government of Barbados** has announced a series of updates to its travel protocols, making it easier for travelers to enter the country. Visitors to the **Caribbean** country now have more options with the acceptance of rapid antigen tests for entry, once administered by a healthcare provider no more than one day prior to arrival in the island country.

According to the Barbadian government, rapid antigen tests are widely available in the country's primary source markets and results are typically returned within one hour. Rapid antigen tests join the list of approved tests for entry to Barbados. The island also accepts **COVID-19** PCR tests taken no more than three days prior to arrival in Barbados. The COVID-19 tests can be taken using samples administered by nasopharyngeal, oropharyngeal, nasal, anterior nares or mid-turbinate swabs. However, the following PCR tests will not be accepted: self-administered swabs; shallow nasal swabs; and saliva tests.

Furthermore, passengers transiting through Barbados will not be asked to provide test results in order to do so. Travelers will also notice changes to the **Grantley Adams**International Airport experience. All paper forms previously distributed on-board aircraft arriving in Barbados will be discontinued. Additionally, travelers will once again be able to utilize the more spacious main arrivals hall, instead of the temporary Gate 14-16 arrivals hall that had previously been set up to manage port health entry checks and testing during the pandemic.

# NORWEGIAN CRUISE LINE RAISES DAILY GRATUITY CHARGE

Starting April 1, guests onboard Norwegian Cruise Line ships will be paying more for the onboard service charge. The increase ranges from 50 cents a day for those staying in all cabins to \$1.50 for those staying in The Haven or other suites. The new service charges will be \$20 per person, per day in The Haven or suites (up from \$18.50), Balcony and below will be \$16 per person per day (up from \$15.50).

Guests making a new reservation prior to March 31 have the option to prepay their service charge at the current rate.
