European Union Delays Launch of ETIAS Until At Least 2024

The European Union (EU) has officially delayed the launch of the European Travel Information and Authorisation System (ETIAS) until at least 2024.

The EU has not provided a specific launch date for the ETIAS, but it has been confirmed that it will not take effect in November 2023 as originally planned, and will instead be launched sometime next year.

The ETIAS, which has been in the works since 2016, will require all non-Europeans, including those in the United Kingdom, United States, and Canada, to obtain an electronic travel permit ahead of arrival. This requirement applies to all travelers who do not need a visa prior to travel.

When the ETIAS is launched, each applicant will have to pay 7 euros (approximately \$7.40 US or \$9.55 CAD) for a permit that will be valid for three years. According to the ETIAS website, the application process should take no longer than 10 minutes, and 95% of applicants will be approved within minutes. Travelers will only need their passport, a credit card, or a debit card to pay for the permit, and no biometric data will be collected during the application process.

It's worth noting that the EU is not the only government entity to require authorization prior to travel. For example, the U.S. has a similar program called the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA), which is required for anyone boarding a plane or vessel bound for the U.S. The ESTA costs \$21 US per applicant, and in most cases, applicants receive notification of their application status in real time.

The U.K. has also recently announced that it will implement its own <u>Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA)</u> system by the end of 2023. The ETA will be required for all inbound international travelers outside of Britain and Ireland and will be valid for at least two years, allowing travelers to use it for multiple trips. While the cost of the ETA has not been revealed, the expectation is that it will be a small fee similar to other countries' pre-travel authorization systems.

Royal Caribbean Axes Classic Dishes on Dining Room Menus

Royal Caribbean cruisers can no longer get a grilled chicken or salmon every night for dinner. Same for shrimp cocktail and onion soup now that the line has finished the rollout of its new dinner menus that have seen the elimination of the classic dishes section.

Instead, each night's menu is themed and may offer one or two items that used to be on the classics menu – but not the same item each night.

Off-menu order is not permitted, as is clearly displayed on the menu: "Requests for items that are not on this menu can only be accommodated for allergens or dietary restrictions."



If a cruiser doesn't like what's on the menu at all, they have only a few choices. They can ask for a side that's listed with one of the dishes on the menu. They can ask for veggies – again that are already on the menu listed with something else. Asking for the kid's menu is another option.

CRISPY SHEET PAN GNOCCI WITH SAUSAGES AND PEPPERS

Broil —Instead of Boil—Gnocchi in this quick sheet pan dinner. Peppers, onions, tomatoes and sausage for the little potato dumplings, which are crusted with parmesan and broiled until crispy and tender.

Ingredients:

- pound sweet Italian sausage, casings removed, crumbled
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 small green bell pepper, thinly sliced
- 1 small red bell pepper, thinly sliced
- 1 small yellow bell pepper, thinly sliced
- 1 small red onion, thinly sliced
- 2 tablespoons olive oil

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper
Two 14-ounce cans cherry tomatoes
One 17.5-ounce package potato gnoochi
1/4 cup grated Parmesan, plus more for serving
1/4 cup fresh parsley leaves, chopped

Directions:

- 1 Preheat the oven to 425 degrees F.
- 2 Toss together the sausage, oregano, red pepp garlic, bell peppers, onion, 1 tablespoon of th 1 teaspoon salt and a few grinds of black pepper pan. Pour the cherry tomatoes over top and gentl distribute. Bake until the sausage is cooked throuminutes.
- 3 Meanwhile, toss the gnoochi with the Parmes: 1/2 teaspoon salt.
- 4 Turn the oven to broil. Sprinkle the gnocchi ov until dark golden brown, 3 to 5 minutes. Divid parsley and more Parmesan.

GOVERNOR JOSH GREEN, M.D., MAYOR BISSEN, AND THE RED CROSS CONTINUE TO ASSURE THE PUBLIC THAT HOUSING FOR DISPLACED WILDFIRE SURVIVORS WILL NOT BE IN JEOPARDY AS A RESULT OF THE REOPENING.

THE HAWAI'I TOURISM AUTHORITY ADVISES TRAVELERS TO CHECK WITH INDIVIDUAL ACCOMMODATIONS, ACTIVITIES AND BUSINESSES IN WEST MAUI FOR THEIR AVAILABILITY AND HOURS OF OPERATION.
