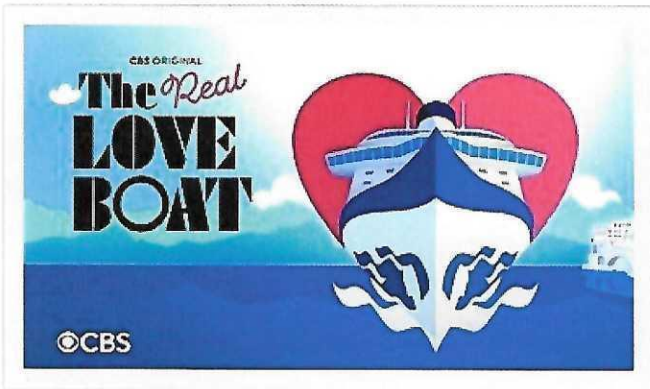


## CBS's "The Real Love Boat" Sets Sail on October 5th

## OBERAMMERGAU 2022

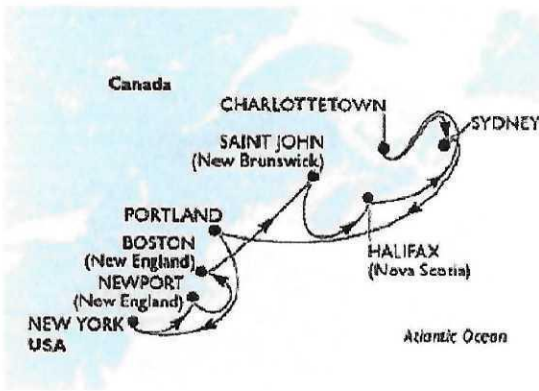
The Passion Play has been continually performed every ten years since 1680 and either cancelled or postponed only a handful of times. COVID postponed the 2020 schedule to this year and if you missed it, you will have to wait until 2030 for your next opportunity to see the play.

Every participant in the play must be a resident of the small German village of Oberammergau for at least 20 years and 2,000 locals fill the minor roles. The main characters devote at least a year of their life to the performance with men growing only natural beards.

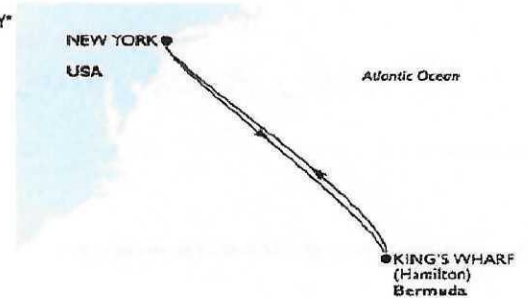

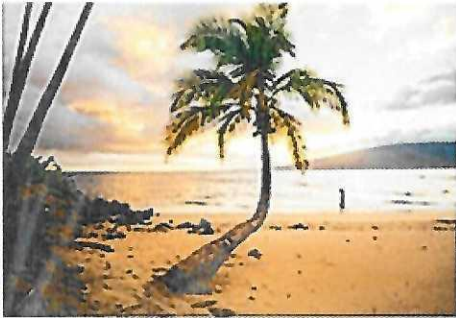
