Spirit Airlines closing N.J. crew hub at Atlantic City airport



Spirit Airlines, one of the nation's largest air carriers, will close one of its New Jersey crew hubs later this year as part of a larger restructuring plan announced Monday.

The airline will cease operations of its crew base at Atlantic City International Airport on Sept. 1, a Spirit spokesperson said Tuesday. The company cited a gradual decline in flights from Atlantic City. Spirit is the airport's lone carrier, running non-stop flights mostly between South Jersey and Florida.

Delta Air Lines Will Soon Update the Way It Boards Passengers



Delta Air Lines flyers will soon board its planes in a new way that might remind them of the past.

Beginning May 1, the airline will board customers by numbered zones, a change that largely reverts back to process it used until early 2019, before changing to its current process of boarding by named categories (i.e. cabins, status and ticket types).

Delta will maintain the same boarding order, but the categories will be called "zones," beginning with zone 1 and ending with zone 8.

For example, "Pre-Boarding" and "First Class" categories will be called zone 1, the "Comfort+" category is being changed to zone 3 and the "Main Cabin" groups will now be grouped in zones 5 through 7, before ending with "Basic Economy" now in zone 8.

The new numbered zones will be printed on customers' boarding passes.

Next month's changes mean the end of a five-year boarding process that Delta changed to board its plane on the branded fares that customers purchased as part of an effort to bring "consistency, simplicity and clarity to the gate and boarding experience."

It also introduced colors on gate screens and electronic boarding passes to the boarding process to help flyers identify their zone, which the airline will keep using.

Zone boarding, an aviation standard for decades, will soon be a thing of the past for Delta customers, the airline said in a 2018 release. It also expanded the number of boarding groups to encourage fewer customers to line up in the gate area at any one time.

Delta will be keeping the same number of zones, too.

Of course, any flyer knows that boarding is usually a chaotic process that no US carrier has exactly nailed down.

United Airlines recently changed its boarding procedure for economy class passengers, with window seat passengers boarding first, followed by middle seat and then aisle seats. The airline said the process saves "up to two minutes of boarding time."

Saving even one minute in airplane turn time can sum up to several hundred million dollars per year for a large airline.

American Airlines switched to a nine-group boarding system in 2017 and made some tweaks to that system in 2023.

Carrot Cake with Cream Cheese Frosting

Level: Easy Total: 3 hr Prep: 10 min

Inactive: 2 hr 10 min Cook: 40 min Yield: 10 servings

Ingredients:

Cake:

Cooking spray

2 cups pecan halves

2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour

1 tablespoon plus 1 teaspoon baking powder

1 1/2 teaspoons cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon freshly grated nutmeg

Kosher salt

4 large eggs

2 cups granulated sugar

1 cup vegetable oil

3 cups finely grated carrots (about 1 pound carrots)

2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract

Frosting:

1 pound cream cheese, cut into cubes, at room temperature

2 sticks unsalted butter, cut into cubes, at room temperature

2 1/2 cups confectioners' sugar

1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract

Kosher salt

1/4 cup heavy cream, cold

Directions:

- 1 For the cake: Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F. Line two 9-inch round cake pans with parchment and lightly coat with cooking spray.
- 2 Spread the pecans on a rimmed baking sheet and toast until light brown and fragrant, 7 minutes. Set aside 12

pecan halves to decorate the finished cake; chop the remaining pecans. Set aside 1 cup of the chopped pecans to use in the batter; reserve the rest for decorating the finished cake.

- 3 Whisk together the flour, baking powder, cinnamon, nutmeg and 1 teaspoon salt in a medium bowl.
- 4 Whisk together the eggs and granulated sugar in a large bowl until smooth, about 1 minute. Whisk in the oil until well combined. Add the grated carrots, vanilla and 1 cup chopped pecans, and mix well. Add the dry ingredients, and stir until just combined. Divide the batter evenly between the prepared pans.
- 5 Bake until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean and the cakes are nicely browned, about 30 minutes. Let cool on a cooling rack for 10 minutes. Loosen the edges with a spatula, turn the cakes out and let cool completely, right-side up, on the cooling rack, about 2 hours. Remove the parchment before frosting.
- 6 For the frosting: Beat the cream cheese and butter in the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with a paddle attachment, scraping down the side as necessary, until smooth, about 2 minutes. Add the confectioners' sugar, vanilla and 1/2 teaspoon salt; gradually increase the mixer speed to medium-high, and beat until the sugar is incorporated and the frosting is fluffy and smooth, about 3 minutes. With the mixer on medium-high, add the cream a few drops at time until it's all incorporated. Continue beating for 1 more minute until the frosting is slightly lighter in color and creamy.
- 7 To assemble: Place one of the cake layers on a serving plate, and spread 1 cup of the frosting over the top. Top with the other layer, and use the remaining frosting to frost the top and sides of the cake. Arrange the 12 whole pecans on top of the cake like the numbers on a clock face, and sprinkle the remaining chopped pecans in between.
