



Grilled Tequila Garlic Lime Flank Steak

Level: Easy

Total: 3 hr 15 min (includes marinating time)

Prep: 25 min

Inactive: 2 hr 35 min

Cook: 15 min

Yield: 6 servings

Ingredients:

1 cup roughly chopped garlic (about 3 bulbs)
3/4 cup freshly squeezed lime juice (about 8 large limes)
1/2 cup clear tequila
1/4 cup soy sauce
1 bunch roughly chopped fresh cilantro, leaves and stems
1 jalapeno pepper, seeded and diced
1 serrano pepper, seeded and diced
1 teaspoon cumin powder
1 tablespoon freshly cracked black pepper
1 1/2 to 2 pounds flank steak
12 corn tortillas, wrapped in foil

Directions:

- 1 Combine the garlic, lime juice, tequila, soy sauce, cilantro, peppers, cumin and black pepper in a resealable plastic gallon bag. Add the steak and let marinate in the refrigerator for 2 hours. Remove from the refrigerator, and let marinate at room temperature another 30 to 45 minutes.
- 2 Prepare a grill to medium-high heat. Remove the steak from the marinade, reserving the marinade. Put the marinade in small saucepot and bring to a boil. Then strain and reserve.
- 3 Put the tortillas on the corner of the grill and flip the package a few times to heat through while the steak is cooking
- 4 Place the steak on the grill. Cook for 4 minutes, turn 180 degrees, and cook for 3 minutes more (to create cross grill marks). Flip over and finish cooking for 3 to 5 minutes, depending on desired doneness. Remove from the grill to a cutting board and let rest, lightly covered, for 5 minutes.
- 5 Slice against the grain, and serve immediately with the reserved marinade, garnishes, tortillas and hot sauce.



For decades, no fees for a first or second checked bag was a pillar of Southwest Airlines' brand.


No more..

They announced that beginning May 27, passengers are being charged \$35 for a first checked bag and \$45 for a second checked bag. An investor group has pushed Southwest to maximize shareholder value by implementing the fee in line with those charged by most of Southwest's competitors, such as JetBlue, American Airlines and United Airlines.



The bag fees will be charged to passengers traveling on *Anytime*, *Wanna Get Awat Plus* and the new *Basic* fare categories. Fees for the first and second bags will be waived for Business Select customers. Holders of the Southwest Rapid Rewards credit card, *A-List* and *A-List-Preferred* members will get one free checked bag, plus one free bag for up to eight people traveling on the same reservation. A second bag will continue to be free for *A-List-Preferred* customers but will cost *A-List* members \$35. and credit card holders will pay the full \$45. The same maximum of eight companions traveling on the same reservation applies to this pricing scheme.

The bag fees are part of a broader restructuring of Southwest's policies, notably ending the airline's open-seating policy in favor of assigned seating. Like other airlines, Southwest also will begin charging more for preferred seats. Changes also are being made to how loyalty points are earned, based on booking class and passenger premier status.


