## Potato Chip-Crusted Chicken Strips with Honey Mustard Dipping Sauce

### Ingredients:

#### Chicken:

1 cup all-purpose flour  
2 teaspoons garlic powder  
2 teaspoons onion powder  
1 teaspoon paprika  
1 teaspoon ground mustard  
Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper  
3 large eggs  
16 to 20 ounces your favorite BBQ or salt and vinegar potato chips (I like Zapp's Voodoo)  
2 pounds boneless chicken breast, cut into strips

#### Honey Mustard Sauce:

1/2 cup honey  
5 tablespoons mayonnaise  
1/4 cup Dijon mustard  
1 tablespoon yellow mustard  
1 tablespoon whole-grain mustard  
1/4 teaspoon garlic powder  
Kosher salt


### Directions:

- 1 For the chicken: Preheat the oven to 450 degrees F. Line a baking sheet with parchment.
- 2 In a bowl or baking dish, add the flour, garlic powder, onion powder, paprika, ground mustard and 2 teaspoons each salt and pepper and stir to combine. Beat the eggs in a separate baking dish. Finely crush the potato chips in their bag or in a separate resealable bag. Pour into a bowl or baking dish.
- 3 Sprinkle the chicken with 2 teaspoons salt. Dip the chicken in the seasoned flour and coat completely, then into the egg mixture until completely coated. Finally, dip the chicken into the potato chips, making sure the chips stick to the whole surface. Transfer the chicken to the prepared baking sheet.
- 4 Bake, flipping halfway through, until the chicken is golden brown and reaches an internal temperature of 165 degrees F, about 20 minutes.
- 5 For the honey mustard sauce: While the chicken is baking, mix together the honey, mayonnaise, Dijon, yellow mustard, whole-grain mustard and garlic powder in a small bowl. Season with salt as desired. Serve with the chicken.

**The weather:** Jamaica is a temperate island. Most days, it's hot, so packing sunscreen should be a given. You will want to protect your skin during the daytime, as the notably intense sunlight here can do major damage. Remember to pack some sun protection, or get some as soon as your flight lands from one of the airport's souvenir stores.




## APPLETON ESTATE RUM




## BLUE MOUNTAIN COFFEE

# Ship captain and social media star Kate McCue is leaving Celebrity Cruises

"You might be wondering why I am leaving. Simply put, life has an incredible way of reminding us what's important and changing up priorities. I've recently had some big life changes, and this just happens to be one of those," she wrote.

McCue has spent the last 22 years on 11 ships with Royal Caribbean Group, she said. Most recently, she has been captain of the Celebrity Beyond.

McCue was named commanding officer of the Celebrity Summit in 2015, becoming the first American woman to captain a large cruise ship. McCue also captained the Celebrity Equinox and Celebrity Edge. As famous as McCue was her hairless cat, Bug Naked, who lived with her on the ship. Bug died late last year.

Leading up to the Beyond's debut in 2022, McCue was a spokeswoman for Celebrity, starring in videos promoting the line's third Edge-class ship.

"Are my sailing days over? Absolutely not!" she wrote in her Instagram announcement. "I've got too much salt in my veins to leave the sea behind."
