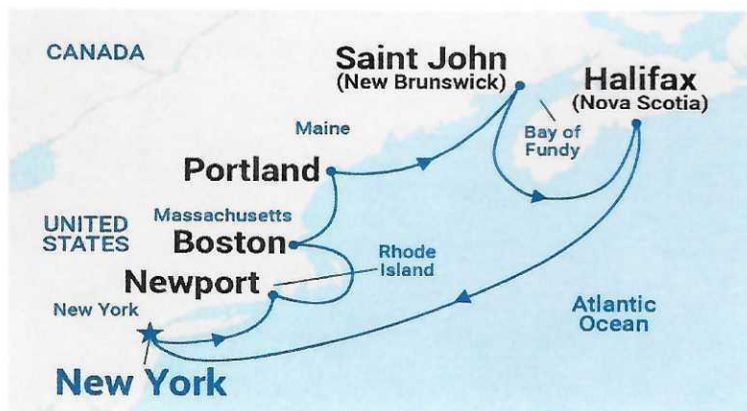

Know Your Monument — Eiffel Tower

A Premium Architectural Guide

WHERE IS IT?

Paris, France. Located on the Champ de Mars beside the Seine in the 7th arrondissement, easily reached via Bir-Hakeim metro or Champ de Mars–Tour Eiffel RER.

HOW TO REACH

From Charles de Gaulle Airport, take the RER B into central Paris, then connect to RER C or the metro toward Bir-Hakeim. Journey time is usually about 60–75 minutes. Taxi typically takes 45–60 minutes depending on traffic.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

Spring and autumn offer ideal weather. For fewer crowds, aim for weekday mornings, especially Tuesday to Thursday. Sunset adds very different atmosphere.

TIPS & RULES

- Book timed-entry tickets on the official website toureiffel.paris for best prices and fewer queues.
- Visit early morning (9–11am) or late evening (8–10:30pm) for shorter waits.
- If summit tickets are sold out, consider stairs-to-second-floor tickets for a great alternative.
- Expect airport-style security screening and avoid bringing bulky bags.
- The summit can close in bad weather, so check conditions before your visit.
- Stay after dark to see the hourly sparkle illuminations from nearby viewpoints.

DESCRIPTION

Built for the 1889 Exposition Universelle and designed by Gustave Eiffel, the tower rises 330 metres and remains one of the world's most recognizable landmarks. Its three levels offer sweeping city views, its historic exhibits and the iconic summit experience.

ENTRY FEE

Second Floor by Stairs: from €14.80.
Second Floor by Lift: from €23.50.
Summit by Lift: from €36.70.
Children under 4: Free.

HOW LONG TO SPEND

For the first and second floors, allow about 1.5 hours. For a summit visit, plan roughly 2.5 hours, or longer if dining onsite.

TIMINGS

Generally open daily around 9:30 AM–11:45 PM, with longer summer hours. Check official calendar for seasonal changes.
