

Enjoy Iceland Christmas markets during a magical and festive time

December 3-7,2026

Crowned by the northern lights, Reykjavik in winter is like something of a dream.

**Our Adventure begins with non-stop flights on Iceland Air from Newark. On arrival Friday, December 4, our private transfer will take us to the FossHotel Reykjavik for an early morning check-in and full breakfast. The 4-star hotel, nestled in a shopping area, just 1.2 km from the Lutheran Hallgrimskirkja Parish Church. The location is right around the corner from the Hlemmur Food Hall, the hotel overlooks sea and has an à la carte restaurant and bar. 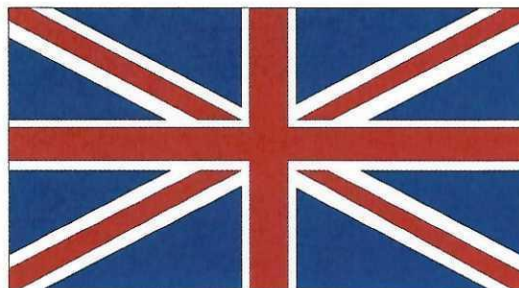

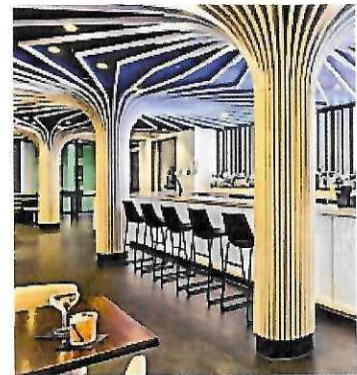
